



The Ukrainian Red Cross has allocated funds for a construction of two modular two-storey houses with a total area of 1 300 m² for more than 100 pregnant IDP women in Lviv



TEMPORARY HOUSING FOR IDPs

Housing buildings for temporary residence with a total area of 12 170 m²

Total area of one building is

685,8 m²

- in Chernihiv region 7 houses (are already under 2 435 persons 1,4800 m² construction)
- in Zakarpattia region 2 houses (are planned) & 120 persons 1 1 370 m²

Total area of one building is

50 m²

- in Zhytomyr region 40 houses (are planned) 2 120 persons 1 2 000 m²
- Kyiv region 80 houses (are planned)
 240 persons 1 4 000 m²



PAYMENTS UNDER THE "PRYKHYSTOK" PROGRAM

Provide for financial compensation for housing and communal services to private households who sheltered internally displaced persons from temporarily occupied territories or zones of active hostilities.

The Ukrainian Red Cross Society joined the financing of the project in April 2022.

The program will last until the end of 2023.

SUPPORT DURING WINTER

were handed over to the communities of Donetsk, Mykolaiv, Kharkiv, Kherson and Kyiv regions


More than 4 000 of electric heaters

were handed over to the communities of Ivano-Frankivsk, Lviv, Rivne, Ternopil, Zhytomyr, Khmelnytskyi, Volyn, Zakarpattia and Chernivtsi regions

Over 500 generators with a total capacity of more than 8 MW were transferred for the needs of:

- 35 railway stations
- community centers

- 20 hospitals
- 2 water utilities



RESTORATION



More than **2 000 meters** of high-voltage power lines have been restored.



Materials for the restoration of **15 000 meters** of trolleybus lines in Chernihiv city were purchased and handed over.




29 community centers were renovated: Lviv, Zakarpattia, Cherkasy, Dnipropetrovsk, Zaporizhzhia, Kyiv regions.



Over 6 500 m² of window structures were repaired.






